Cover your mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing

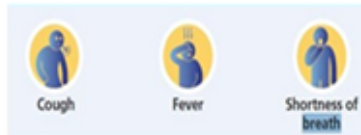


Avoid close contact, if needed think of other protective measures. Mask/face covering required in shops

HOW TO WALK TO TOWN FROM LINK ROAD OR LAWNS CAR PARK

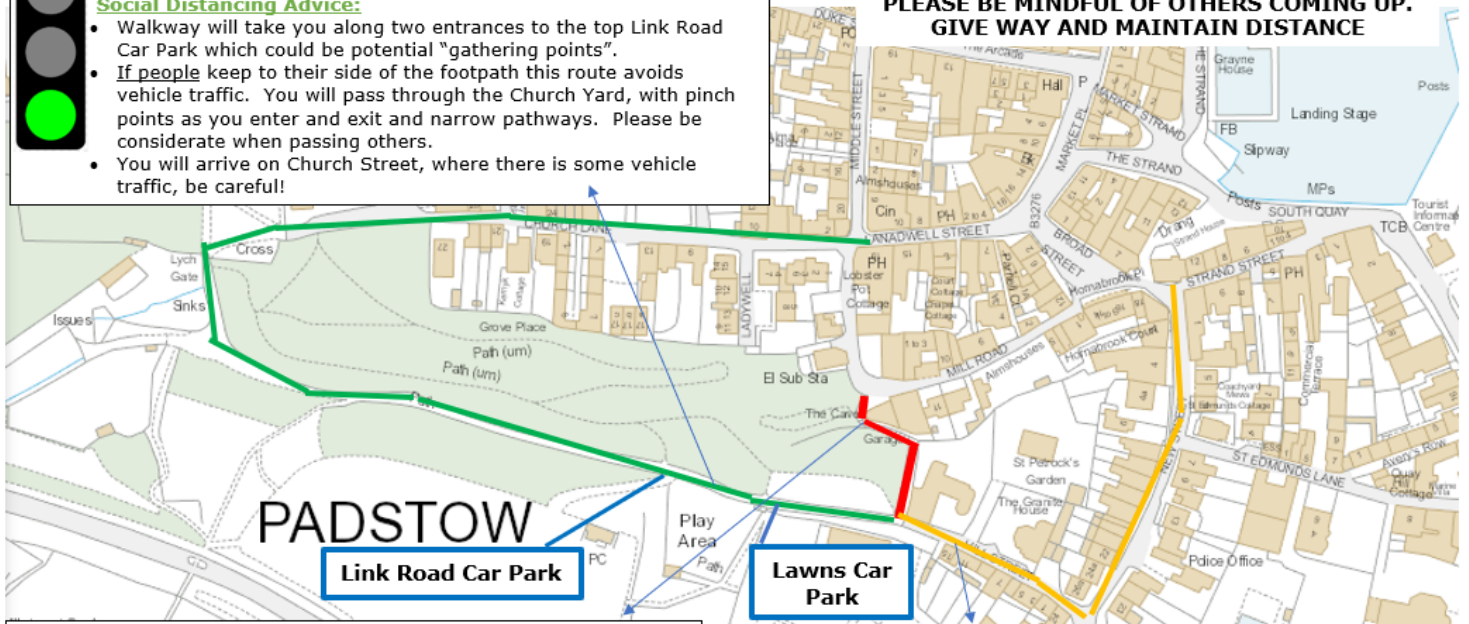

WE HAVE A TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM TO HELP INDICATE EACH ROUTE'S CAPACITY FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING.



TURN LEFT WHICH WILL TAKE YOU THROUGH THE CHURCH YARD TO CHURCH STREET AND TOWN
Social Distancing Advice:

- Walkway will take you along two entrances to the top Link Road Car Park which could be potential "gathering points".
- If people keep to their side of the footpath this route avoids vehicle traffic. You will pass through the Church Yard, with pinch points as you enter and exit and narrow pathways. Please be considerate when passing others.
- You will arrive on Church Street, where there is some vehicle traffic, be careful!

IF COMING FROM CAR PARK STEPS/SLOPES: PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF OTHERS COMING UP. GIVE WAY AND MAINTAIN DISTANCE

DOWN THE HILL STEPS - Social Distancing Advice:

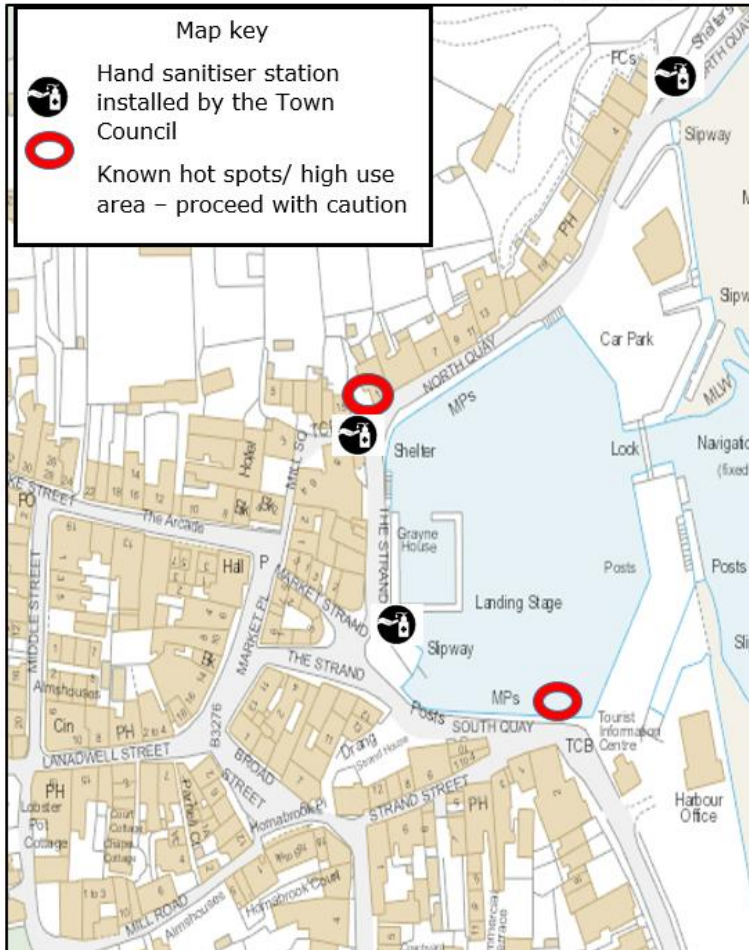
- Most problematic.
- Narrow stepped footway into town.
- Pedestrians will need to be respectful of each other and either wait at the top or bottom to let people through.
- Not preferred route for social distancing, would encourage other routes outlined.



GO RIGHT PAST THE HOUSES ON MILL STREET ONTO NEW STREET
Social Distancing Advice:

- This route enables social distancing to be better maintained provided that people keep to their own side of the roadway.
- When getting onto Hill Street, pavement along one side of the road only as far as the "square" to keep social distancing will mean having to walk into the road. Be careful!
