

People arriving at any UK port from outside the UK, Ireland and the Channel Isles must report their arrival to the UK Border Agency, in accordance with the 1971 Immigration Act.

The full names, Dates of Birth, Nationality, Passport number and a contact number/e-mail address must be telephoned, faxed or e-mailed through to the UK Border Agency in Plymouth or Exeter on the following;
