

Local Notice to Mariners # 2/2019 issued 11th July 2019

PADSTOW TO ROCK SWIM - Sunday14thJULY

- Please be aware that the Marie Curie Estuary Swim from Padstow to Rock takes place on SUNDAY 14th JULY 2019.
- The swim will begin at approximately 15:40 hrs and all competitors will be out of the water by approximately 17:00 hrs.
- Approximately 400 competitors (in two waves) will swim from Padstow Sailing Club to the Lifeboat Slipway at Rock.
- Safety boats will form a 'moving corridor' on either side of the competitors and no
 vessels should pass astern of the lead safety boats or ahead of the last safety
 boats.
- Mariners are requested to keep clear of the area and this event for its short duration. Last year this charity event raised well over £80,000 – so we take the event....and the safety of the competitors very seriously – your cooperation with staying clear of the event on the day is appreciated!
- Any vessels having to navigate in this vicinity at the time of the event are required to do so with extreme care and at dead slow speed.
- A number of canoes / kayaks towing surf boards will be in close attendance to the competitors.
- Safety boats will wave red flags and intercept any vessels which are navigating in a manner likely to conflict with the swimmers.
- Marker buoys will be placed along the line of the course to aid the swimmers 'navigation'. A number of small craft may be anchored for use as rest points for the competitors.
- All communications between the race organiser and safety vessels will be on VHF Ch 6, so please keep this channel clear on the day.
- "River Control" (located aboard the Harbour Patrol RHIB) has responsibility for the safety of the swimmers once in the water.
